- Own association statutes (rules and guidelines).



Legal forms of clubs

- Associations are typically small organizations, who mostly act in a local area.
- Several clubs with the same interests and club purposes can join together to form another club, a so-called 'governing body' (umbrella organization).
- Here you can bundle the interests of the clubs, network and exchange experiences.

Facts and figures

- There are currently around 620,000 clubs in Germany with over 50 million members
 Approx. 27 million volunteers
- More than 90% of all sports, art, music and education events are organized by clubs in cooperation with local authorities.
- Volunteers generate about 4.6% of the gross domestic product with their mostly unpaid work, which is about 40 billion €.

 - Fladungen Classics





• oldtimer festival

- about 15.000 visitors
- 400 special selected oldtimers are allowed to enter city
- whole city is decorated in the style of the 50's/60's
- tipical shops, food and drinks from the 50's/60's
- vintage ferris wheel
- lifemusic out of that time
- no modern cars allowed







The problems of crises for associations, example of the corona-crisis

- Because of social distancing and political decisions there where a lot of limitations for the associations
 - the membership in an association is mostly conected with personal interessts
 - a lot of people got their friends in the associations
 - events organisated by the associations were cancelt
 - people lose a lot of their social life
 - change of interessts
 - people get more lazy
